

**FOR WATERCOLOUR :**



**PAPER**

1 x 14" x 10" watercolour paper book or pre-glued block pad 140lb/300gms.  
1 x A5 sketch pad.

**BRUSHES**

- 1 x No 10 round watercolour brush.
- 1 x No 6 round watercolour brush, preferably sable.
- 1 x 'one stroke flat' brush either sable or nylon
- 1 x organic sponge

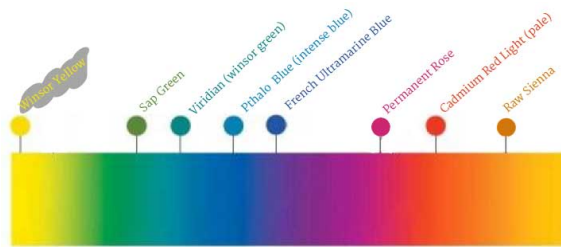

**WATERCOLOUR PAINTS**

- 8ml or 21ml tubes or dry pan sets. Daler Rowney/Winsor & Newton. Artists quality is better than student quality.

- 1 x French Ultramarine Blue
- 1 x Cobalt blue
- 1 x Cerulean blue
- 1 x Cadmium Red
- 1 x Permanent Rose
- 1 x Artists Quality Transparent Yellow (windsor yellow)
- 1 x Raw Sienna
- 1 x Burnt Sienna
- 1 x Sap Green
- 1 x Dioxazin Violet (windsor violet)
- 1 x Neutral Tint
- Permanent white designers gouache



**Mapping Pigments to the spectrum.** To understand the cool & warm varieties of each colour, it is helpful to see where each pigment falls along the colour spectrum. The magenta-like Permanent Rose, for example, lies closer to the violet end of the spectrum, while red light is relatively warmer and lies towards the yellow end of the spectrum.

**OTHER ITEMS**

- 4 bulldog clips
- 1 x 2H & 1 x 2B pencil, eraser.
- 2 x plastic mixing palettes, preferably with wells

**FOR ALKYDS & ACRYLICS**

Same colours as for watercolour plus Titanium White & Black instead of Neutral Tint. Acrylics need a 'stay wet' palette & nylon brushes. Alkyds are fast drying oil paints & need hog hair brushes. Either canvas boards or canvas paper. Six minimum of size 30 x 40 cm/12 x 16" approx.

We offer the possibility of 'renting' a complete set of alkyds or acrylics. Just bring your own brushes & canvas boards or canvas paper.

There is a fully equipped studio, with painting furniture (easels, boards, jars, tape, solvents, rags, chairs, sun umbrellas etc) so you can fly light. An art book library.
